Science Everyday Materials	History The Great Fire of London -Significant event	Geography Weather/Poles Apart
<p>The children will distinguish between an object and the material it is made from. The children will focus on identifying and naming a variety of common everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock. They will describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials, compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.</p>	<p>The children will learn about The Great Fire of London. The children will focus on understanding the event's causes, consequences, and impact on London, using primary and secondary sources to learn about the past. They will learn about the fire's impact on daily life, the changes it brought to London's architecture and city planning, and how firefighting methods have evolved.</p>	<p>The children Identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in the UK and the location of hot and cold areas in the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South Poles They will use basic geographical vocabulary, world maps, atlases and globes to locate the North and South Poles and the Equator</p>

<p>The children will be learning symbolism through colour. They will research how colour can create a mood and feeling. The children will learn about primary and secondary colours. Pupils will create their own colour wheels using primary colours of paint and mixing to make secondary colours.</p>	<p>The children will design and make their own bread. In this half term the children will also take part in a number of transition activities, as they prepare to move to a new class and year group.</p>
